A Message From Pastor Jihoon Lee

Dear Friends in Christ,

The profound truth of Jesus coming in human form is foundational to our faith. He didn't manifest as a creature like a duck or a dog, nor did He choose the form of a caterpillar or a goldfish. Instead, Jesus came in the very flesh that defines our humanity – in the form of men, women, and children. He embraced the image of God that resides within each of us, a reminder that His purpose was intimately tied to us.

Why did He come? It was an act of divine grace and love. He arrived to stand in our place, to endure suffering on our behalf, and to fulfill God's law flawlessly in our stead. His resurrection symbolizes the promise of our own redemption.

The imagery of the baby Jesus in a manger during Christmas is beautiful, yet it's essential to remember the profound reason behind His incarnation in our flesh. He came not merely to exist among us but to be our ultimate Savior. He offered His life for ours, spilled His blood for our cleansing, and suffered on the cross to absolve all sins.

Think of it like being carried along on a sled – just as someone toils to pull the sled, Christ labored for our salvation. Scripture tells us that we've been carried along by His hard work and sacrifices for us (Hebrews 4:8).

As we approach Christmas, let's reflect on the significance of Christ's coming and the ongoing work He does for our salvation. He doesn't cease His arrival; rather, He continues to reach us, not in a manger but in the symbols of the chalice and the waters of baptism.

The Word becomes flesh for us each day, resonating in the preaching, readings, and angelic hymns of our worship.

December is a big month. It's the month of "Advent" – where we remember the first coming of God the Son into our world, and long for the second coming of Jesus Christ when He returns for His church.
