Communion at Central United Methodist Church

When we share the cup and bread, persons may stand or kneel as they are comfortable. Persons are also free to commune in spirit through prayer, at the communion rail or in your pew, without receiving the bread and cup. Children are welcome at the Lord's Table. The decision on when children are ready to receive communion is left to the discretion of their parents/guardians.
