Communion at Central United Methodist Church

United Methodists celebrate an “open table;” you do not need to belong to this congregation or denomination to receive communion, but simply desire to draw close to God through faith in Jesus Christ.

If you cannot come forward, please let an usher know, and the elements will be brought to you where you are seated.

When we share the cup and bread, persons may stand or kneel as they are comfortable. Persons are also free to commune in spirit through prayer, at the communion rail or in your pew, without receiving the bread and cup.

Children are welcome at the Lord's Table. The decision on when children are ready to receive communion is left to the discretion of their parents/guardians.
