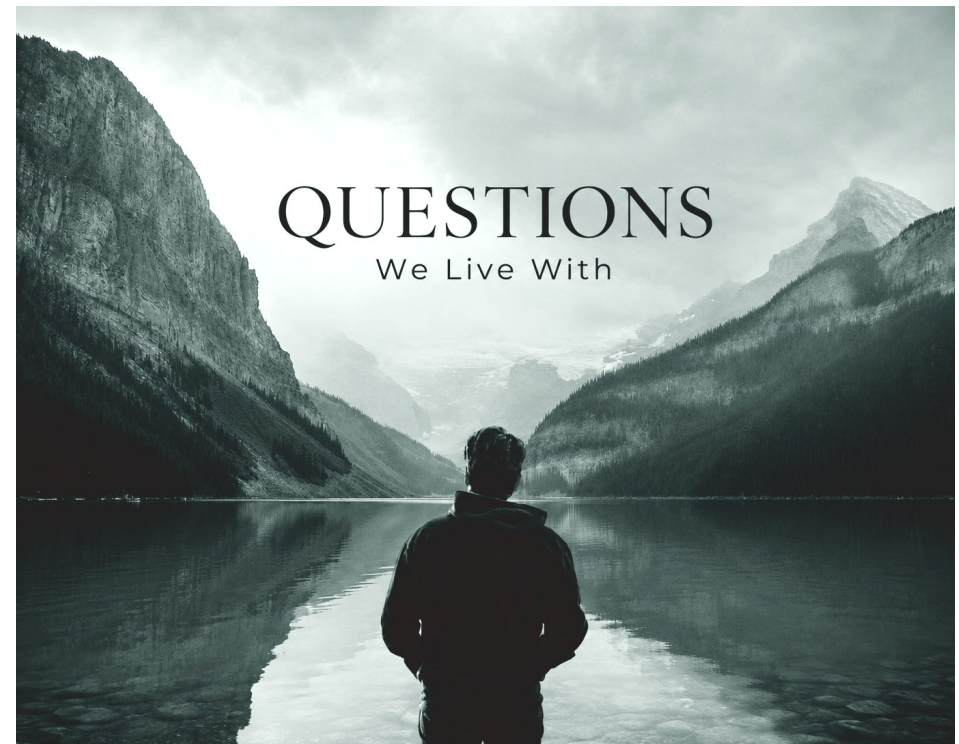

Communion at Central United Methodist Church

United Methodists celebrate an "open table;" you do not need to belong to this congregation or denomination to receive communion, but simply desire to draw close to God through faith in Jesus Christ.
